Snow Plowing Specs

1. Snow Removal

- a. All snowfalls over 2” shall be plowed curb to curb. Snow is to be plowed within 4 hours from 2” level of accumulation.
- b. An additional plowing is required for each additional 4” of accumulation.
- c. Cul-de-sacs are to be plowed so there is no snow piled up in the courts
- d. Mailboxes, sidewalk corners, and driveways shall not be plowed in. Mail person will not deliver if they cannot drive up to each individual box. Additionally children are picked up on the corners and if snow is piled up then it becomes a safety hazard for the children. We understand that drifting snow may cause some driveways to become blocked. Please use every effort possible to keep driveways clear.

2. Salting

- a. Salt is to be applied for 2” of snow accumulation or **less** when salt is called for freezing rain and when temps stay below freezing after snowfalls. Please list prices and estimated tons of salt needed for the following:

Entrance/Exit – Carlson Park Rd.

Intersections – 10 intersections total (including curves in road on Thistle and Ivy Lane – see map)

Please state whether or not your company stakes/flags at all. Any damages to mailboxes, irrigation heads, and/or common subdivision property will be responsible by the snow plowing company.
